Who We Are

The Suicide Fatality Review Team (SFRT) is a multiagency group of professionals who meet quarterly to learn more about the circumstances leading to suicide deaths in Laramie County.

The purpose of the SFR is to prevent future suicides in Laramie County. Based on research, the SFR will identify risk and protective factors for suicide that are unique to Laramie County and make recommendations for local policy and practice changes to help reduce suicide and promote safety.

Our Process

- Collect uniform data and accurate statistics on suicide.
- Identify circumstances surrounding suicide deaths that could prevent future suicide.
- Promote collaboration and coordination among participating agencies.
- Implement cooperative protocols for the standard review of suicides.
- Provide a confidential forum for multiple agencies and disciplines.
- Identify and address system and community factors that contribute to suicide.
